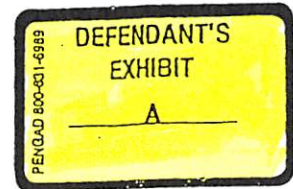

ORDER

Currently before the Court are various documents (Docs. 145, 146, 164, 166) which have been filed as Replies to the Government's Response to Defendant's 28 U.S.C. § 2255 motion. The undersigned will not wade through these documents, which consist of nearly 400 pages, to discern Defendant's arguments in Reply to the Government's Response. Accordingly, these documents will not be considered by the Court. Defendant shall have until August 12, 2014, to file a Reply that shall be limited to 20 pages and shall succinctly address the issues raised in the Government's Response. Defendant is prohibited from using his Reply to re-argue his grounds for relief, to challenge previous rulings made by the undersigned, or to address any issues other than those raised in the Government's Response. The undersigned's consideration of the merits of Defendant's § 2255 motion will be limited to the motion itself (Doc. 87), Defendant's Brief and Exhibit (Docs. 139, 153) in support of the motion, the Government's Response (Doc. 160), and any Reply that Defendant files in compliance with this order. Any Reply Defendant files that fails to comply with this order will be stricken and his § 2255 motion will then be decided without consideration of a Reply. This ruling renders Defendant's Motion to Strike (Doc. 168) moot and the District Court Clerk is directed to terminate the motion as such.
